For over 50 years, the annual ITKF Camp was held at the University of California's UCSD San Diego campus. This year, because of recent changes in university policy regarding reservation of facilities, ITKF has decided to ensure this camp continues its rich tradition by selecting another site, one that is easily accessible to the many European/Mediterranean/African/Middle East federation members.

As previously announced, top masters will be in attendance to conduct the technical portion of the camp, supported by the ITKF Technical Chairman, Richard Jorgensen and the Technical Committee Members.

This year's camp, co-hosted by the European Traditional Karate Federation (ETKF) and the Balkan Federation, will continue to offer the much sought after and highly technical Masters' Course, ITKF Dan Ranking examinations and Certification for Instructors and Judges upon successful course completion and examination.

### CAMP PROGRAM

ITKF has established a historic new Traditional Karate training system based on Budo philosophy and fundamental principles, supported by evidence and research of sports science. The ITKF Camp offers a unique program that incorporates, in one total package, the new Traditional Karate training system and competition based on Budo, regardless of style. This year's training will focus on the link between these principles and the training opportunity of competition – with a particular focus on youth.

#### 1. General Course

Traditional Karate principles applied to techniques in general using the new system.

#### 2. Masters' Course

- a. Applied Traditional Karate principles as educational art and Budo in training, instruction and competition using the ITKF training system and Competition Rules.
- b. Coaches' Certification Course and Judges' Registration Course with examinations for both.

**Note: One year "Instructors License" will be issued to qualified member technical officials upon completion of Masters' Course and successful examinations for both Coaches and Judges.**

#### 3. Medical Clinic for Medical Officials.

After this date, applications will still be accepted; however, full price (\$950.00 Participation + \$250.00 Masters Course) will be charged.

2. Personal checks will be accepted prior to June 20, 2013. All payments made after that date must be in cash or cashier's check. Personal checks will not be accepted.
3. Camp participants must purchase Travelers Insurance for the entire duration of Camp.

The local market offers a large variety of traditional and modern products. Bus services from Nea Flogita to any destination in Halkidiki or Thessaloniki are frequent during the summer season. Archaeological sites are within reasonable distances and excursions are organized daily from the village. Local people are known to be warm hearted, friendly and always welcoming.

## ACCOMODATIONS

**HOTELS:** Hotel Marialena and Mavridis, both located in Nea Flogita. The rooms are triple and four bedrooms. Our Participation Package includes room and breakfast/dinner.

## TRANSPORTATION

**Airport:** Makedonia Thessaloniki International Airport (40 km. from Nea Flogita). Transportation will be arranged from Makedonia Thessaloniki Airport to Hotel and to the Sport Hall for **50 Euros** per person to cover all transportation needs for the week. \*Please contact the Macedonian Traditional Karate Federation to arrange transportation or please note in your pre-registration form if transportation will be required.
